It was a lot of hard work getting everything done when it needed to be done. I want to thank all of the volunteers that came out and worked these long hours. We had a pretty good turn out of workers. However, there are a lot of people in our chapter that did not work. I know we are all very busy, but this is our primary fund raiser for our chapter. We all need to support our

chapter and to do our part to support The Reno Air Races.

Our EAA chapter volunteers worked a total of 453 hours in the warehouse and 71.5 hours in the ticket sales. Some of these hours were from volunteers that came up from California, we even had one volunteer (Mark Solanch) from the east coast that spent some of his vacation time working with us.
